Fund Objective and Investment Policy

The investment objective of the fund is to provide investors with diversified exposure to predominantly the South African equity market. The fund aims to achieve long term capital growth. Investments to be included in the fund will, apart from assets in liquid form, consist solely of collective investment schemes. The fund will be actively managed and may have exposure to general equity as well as specialist portfolios. The equity exposure will be at least 80% at all times, and the fund may hold up to 45% in foreign assets.

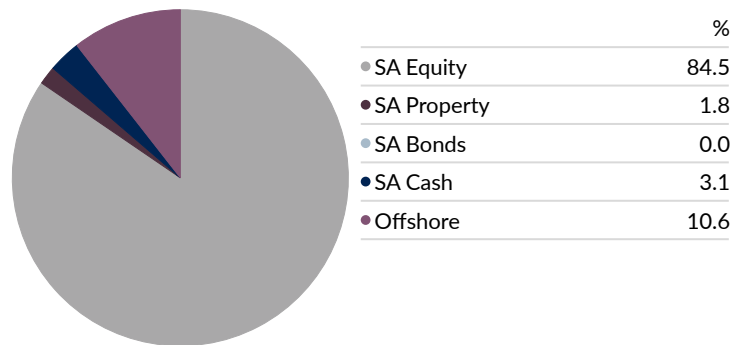

Portfolio Managers Comment

The FG SCI Mercury Equity Fund of Funds returned +2.12% for the month of October, outperforming the benchmark FTSE/JSE All Share Total Return index which returned +1.64%, while underperforming the peer group average return of +2.26%. Global financial markets delivered another positive month in October, supported by strong corporate earnings, while the U.S. government shutdown created uncertainty by delaying key economic data releases. Inflation data was released with delays, showing an uptick to 3%, though still relatively contained, which alongside broader economic concerns led the Fed to cut interest rates by 0.25% to a range of 3.75%-4.00% – the lowest level since 2022. Global trade tensions also eased somewhat after the US and China agreed to a one-year trade truce involving tariff reductions and looser export controls, helping support risk appetite. Locally, domestic sentiment improved following South Africa's removal from the FATF grey list after satisfying all 22 outstanding compliance items, which should reduce compliance cost. Locally, inflation edged up to 3.4%, remaining below expectations and well within the SARB's target band. There was no SARB policy meeting held this month however next month's Medium Term Budget Policy Statement will be closely followed to see if National Treasury confirms the SARB's new inflation target of 3%, making it official. Local listed property (SAPY) was the best performing asset class, returning +7.84% over the month. Local listed equities (FTSE/JSE All Share) returned +1.64% over the month. Resources (-4.79%) detracted from performance, while financials (+8.37%) and industrials (+1.82%) supported performance. The 36ONE BCI SA Equity Fund was the best performing fund, returning +3.66%. No Changes were made to the fund over the month.
